

The 6 Steps of Language Assessment

1. Make an Appointment

2. Registration

You must bring your documents to your assessment. You are eligible for an assessment if you are a Canadian citizen born in another country, a Permanent Resident or a Refugee Claimant, or call to ask if you qualify.



3. Reading and Writing

Your reading and writing assessments will be done in a quiet room with a pencil and paper.





4. Listening and Speaking

Your listening and speaking assessment will be done one-on-one in the assessor's office.

5. Referral

After your assessment your Assessor will go over your results and can help you find a class that fits your personal needs. You can be referred to an ESL class, a LINC class, a Mentorship Program, a Conversation Circle, Employment Services, Settlement Services and more.



6. Class

Each classroom is set up to accommodate the learners in the class.
