CILISAT Testing – Become a Certified Interpreter with Cambridge YMCA

CILISAT testing will assess your language and interpretation skills through the following tests:

- Interpretation from English into selected CILISAT language
- Interpretation from selected CILISAT language into English
- Sight translation from English into selected CILISAT language
- Sight translation from selected CILISAT language into English

Certification is received if 75% is scored on the testing. A cost does apply for the testing
